Vancouver Eye Care is restricting clinic areas for patients only, and asking any accompanying visitors to wait outside the office. All patients are being screened upon arrival with a questionnaire and temperature check.

We have increased the distance between seats in the waiting rooms to minimize the contact between patients.

We have reduced the frequency of appointment slots, so that there will be fewer patients present at any particular time.

Patients who feel ill, or have symptoms or fever, are being asked to reschedule after they have recovered and are no longer potentially contagious.
